Keynote: Prosperity *Master Yap Boh Chu*

Many people know that feng shui is all about prosperity, but what is prosperity? Most equate prosperity with wealth, and will say that feng shui can help to make you rich. Many of you as practitioners must have encountered questions from clients such as "Now that you have done my feng shui, when can I strike lottery?" or "Will I soon become a millionaire?" Is it all that feng shui is about, by making people rich? As a matter of fact, traditional interpretation of "Prosperity" is much more than wealth and Feng Shui is an all-encompassing practice that supports a person in many other ways as well. To truly appreciate what feng shui can do for us, let us delve into Chinese culture to understand more about"福" or "prosperity", and the true meaning of "being rich".

1135 – 1220 Transition from Period 8 to 9 - House Design for Prosperity GM Raymond Lo

In this joint presentation, IFSA Masters Janene Laird and Jen Stone will showcase some of the most widely used San He and San Yuen methods commonly utilised in an external and internal Feng Shui assessment.

Feng Shui, Health & You

Financial Health in Changing Economic Climate of COVID-19 Master Adriel Trinidad

Maintaining a continuing source of income during this COVID-19 pandemic can be challenging, but with Flying Stars Feng Shui, financial health can still be assured with some adjustments. On the contrary, sleeping in a bedroom with inauspicious Mountain Stars is bad for health. Flying Star 2 especially has an energy that invites illness, it is therefore important to pay attention to the direction of how Year Star 2 is moving every year, as well as luck of the residents at those times. Through several case studies, Master Rikako Fujiki will explain the relationship between health and Flying Star Feng Shui.

1535 – 1620 The Historical Purpose of Feng Shui GM Dr Stephen Skinner

The Historical Purpose of Feng Shui was not to 'live in harmony with nature' or 'spiritual ecology' nor was it to just improve the interior decoration. Its purpose was to accumulate qi (ch'i) and to organise it in such a way that the 'luck' of occupants of the building would increase and their life be made easier, more fertile and richer, blessing them with abundance. The original names for these practices were Dili and Kan you, not feng shui. Dili concerned itself with identifying the patterns in the landscape, the presence of mountain dragons and water dragons, and their effects on adjacent buildings, so it is not surprising that the modern Chinese meaning of that word is 'geography'. Kan you related to the timing of changes, and the relationship between direction and time. In the third century these subjects came to be called feng shui, and the effects of wind and water on the accumulation of qi were formulated.

Grand Master Tan Khoon Yong Way FengShui Group, Singapore

Born in Singapore, Grand Master Tan Khoon Yong inherited his forefathers' expertise at the early age of 30 and established Way Chinese Geomancy Centre (currently known as Way Fengshui Group) in 1984. A veteran of geomancy studies, he has been providing Feng Shui consultancy services for more than three decades, and has conducted more than 1000 seminars worldwide. In 2008, he received the prestigious title of "Feng Shui Grand Master" by the IFSA and is the first Feng Shui practitioner in Singapore to be awarded this title. In recognition of his contributions to the society, GM Tan received the Public Service Medal (PBM) in 1999 from then-Singapore President S.R. Nathan. Artistically gifted, GM Tan has in recent years hosted multiple solo art exhibitions in Beijing, Shanghai and Singapore titled "I-Ching with Arts".



Grand Master Raymond Lo Raymond Lo Feng Shui School, Hong Kong

Grand Master Raymond Lo, popularly known as "Fung Shui Lo", is a graduate from the University of Hong Kong. He founded the Raymond Lo School of Feng Shui and Destiny and pioneered the introduction of Feng Shui, Four Pillars of Destiny, I Ching Divination and Auspicious Date Selection in the West, and conducts training classes world-wide. An author, researcher, lecturer, teacher with decades of practice, Grand Master Lo has written 13 best-selling books in English and Chinese, all have been translated into multiple languages. In 2008, the renowned IFSA conferred the title of Grand Master to him for his significant contribution to the industry. Currently, Grand Master Lo serves as vice President of IFSA and is a lecturer in the Hong Kong Federation of Youth Group Living Life Academy and All Masters World.



Grand Master Vincent Koh Singapore Feng Shui Centre (SFSC), Singapore

Grand Master Vincent Koh developed an interest in Feng Shui during his long successful career in the building industry since 1967. In 1997, Grand Master Koh began sharing his knowledge in public seminars and started teaching in collaboration with Singapore Polytechnic's Continuing Education Centre department. He was awarded Singapore Polytechnic's "Continuing Education Award" in 2003, 2005 and 2007. Currently, all Grand Master Koh's courses are endorsed by the IFSA. Grand Master Koh has written five books on Feng Shui, and trained over hundreds of graduates worldwide. He was conferred the title 'Grand Master' by IFSA in 2009. Presently, he carries out research, teaches, mentors and provides professional Feng Shui related services to both individuals and corporate clients. His vast knowledge and experience in buildings and interior design value-adds to his professional practice.



Grand Master Dr Stephen Skinner Golden Hoard, United Kingdom

Grand Master Stephen Skinner wrote the first English book on Feng Shui in the 20th century, the Living Earth Manual of Feng Shui. This book first brought Feng Shui to the attention of the Western world. In 1998 he launched the Feng Shui for Modern Living monthly magazine. With distribution in 41 countries, this magazine helped popularise Feng Shui around the world. Grand Master Skinner launched the 'London International Feng Shui Conference' in 1999, the largest Feng Shui conference ever held in UK/Europe. Today, he is the author of over 46 books that have been translated into more than 20 different languages. In 2015, he was conferred the title of Grand Master by the IFSA. Grand Master Dr Skinner now lives in London, where he researches, writes and consults on Feng Shui.



Master Yap Boh Chu Yap Cheng Hai Feng Shui Academy, Malaysia

Master Yap Boh Chu graduated from Swinburne Institute of Technology (now Swinburne University) Australia, with double majors in Information Technology and Accounting. Following the footsteps of his father, the world renowned late Grand Master Yap Cheng Hai, he received and mastered the science and skill passed down by his father. Since then, Master Yap has become a notable Feng Shui consultant, whose unique approach to Feng Shui successfully marries scientific and traditional, addresses the needs of 21st century and speaks to global audience. Alongside Grand Master Yap, he co-founded Yap Cheng Hai Academy, teaching and spreading the knowledge of Feng Shui internationally. He has worked on various mega projects, including the master planning of Taman Pagoh Jaya in Malaysia, commercial buildings in Canada, Germany, Indonesia, Russia, Saudi Arabia, Singapore and many others.



Master Adriel Trinidad Lightcatchers Crystals, Philippines

Master Adriel Jose-Angelo Trinidad is the head of Feng Shui department of Lightcatchers Crystals, a family owned enterprise in Philippines. At the age of 26, he was the youngest and only male Filipino to be accredited as Feng Shui Master by the International Feng Shui Association (IFSA). An IT graduate, Master AA, as Master Adriel Trinidad is fondly called, completed his Feng Shui studies and training in Japan, Singapore, and Hong Kong under the tutelage and mentorship of internationally acclaimed Feng Shui Grandmaster Raymond Lo. Together with his sister and mother, they integrated what they have learned from GM Lo into their business, promoting holistic personal empowerment and development, and has been credited with continuing to improve the lives and businesses of their numerous clients.



Master Ayuka Kaorumoto Alchemist 32, Japan

Since childhood, Master Ayuka Kaorumoto had had the feeling that her views and thinking were different from others. Through her experiences in a Buddhist kindergarten and serving as a Miko in shrines near her hometown, she became interested in the metaphysical world. When attending college in Japan and the USA, Master Ayuka Kaorumoto learned about Christianity and graduated from The East China Normal University English Department. She realized then that destiny and luck of an individual were pre-determined when they were born, and this realization inspired her to research into esoteric Buddhism, Japanese numerology Kazudama, Tarot, I Ching, and astrology. Master Ayuka Kaorumoto is now a follower of Grand Master Raymond Lo. Together, they have toured across Asia and Europe to promote the global cultivation, awareness and appreciation of Feng Shui.

Master Jacek Kryg School Without Borders, Poland

He is credited as a pioneer in educating the general public in Poland on I Ching and Feng Shui during the early 1980s. His frequent travels to the East over two decades (1970s and 1980s) earned him practical knowledge on Chinese and Indian culture, and also led him to tutor under the late GM Yap Cheng Hai. His own feng shui school "School Without Borders" was established in 1998. Master kryg is the President of IFSA Poland Chapter. He run his own Polish television program "Metafizyka Chñska" or Chinese Metaphysics, and is also the author of some four hundred publications.
