



Grand Master DR STEPHEN SKINNER

Grand Master Dr Stephen Skinner wrote the first feng shui book in English “Living Earth Manual of Feng Shui” in the 20th century, brought Feng Shui to the attention of the Western world. In 1998 he launched the “Feng Shui for Modern Living” monthly magazine, of which 121,000 copies of the inaugural issue were sold. With distribution in 41 countries, this magazine helped popularize Feng Shui around the world. In 1999 he launched the ‘London International Feng Shui Conference’, the largest Feng Shui conference ever held in UK/Europe. In 2004, Grand Master Skinner was part of the Committee that founded the International Feng Shui Association (IFSA) in Singapore.

Grand Master Skinner has published more than a dozen books on Feng Shui, including Advanced Flying Star Feng Shui, Guide to the Feng Shui Compass, Feng Shui Before & After, and the beautiful Feng Shui Style. He has also published four translations of Feng Shui classics: The Water Dragon, The Original Eight Mansions Formula, Key San He Feng Shui Formulas and The Mountain Dragon. In all, he authored over 46 books that have been translated into more than 20 different languages.

Grand Master Skinner was conferred the title of Grand Master in October 2015 at the 12th Annual International Feng Shui Convention by IFSA in Shanghai.

In 2022 he designed and produced a new luopan with updated rings that had not been corrected since the Song dynasty (960) and the Qing dynasty (1644). Accompanied the luopan is a 133 page Handbook that explained each of these rings, something that has never been done before in English. Since then several other luopan manufacturers have decided to also supply small guides.

Grand Master Dr Stephen Skinner now lives in London, where he researches, writes and consults on Feng Shui.
